

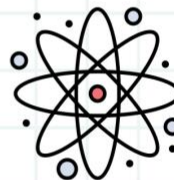
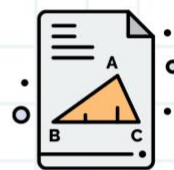

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### SUMMER SCHOOL 2.0

The BHEF TK-5 Summer Academy is excited to offer Summer School 2.0! In light of recent events, this year’s summer academy will be conducted entirely online using Home Learning platforms such as Seesaw, Google Classroom, and Zoom, and we are waiving the \$25 registration fee. Instructions will be emailed for virtual class meetings prior to the start of summer courses.

The BHEF TK-5 Summer Academy is proud to provide a variety of standards skill review, primary get-ahead, as well as other enrichment opportunities for TK-5 students. The TK-5 program runs for **four weeks**, from June 8 – July 1, 2020. **Standard Skills Review Courses** are designed for students in need of remediation and continued academic intervention support. These courses are for students in English Language Arts and Mathematics. In this program, students will receive both English Language Arts and Math intervention support. The program will offer both individual and small group instruction, as well as support through online computer programs. **Primary Get-Ahead Courses** are designed for students respectively entering TK-Kindergarten, First Grade, and Second Grade in the Fall of 2020. These students will get a sneak preview into their upcoming grade level in an academic, creative, and exciting format. **Enrichment Courses** are designed to give students a more specific focus into a precise discipline (writing, math, art, etc.). These students will have the opportunity to explore a current, or even identify a new, passion in a fun, imaginative way.

#### K-5 Standards Skill Review

Grades K–5

The Standards Skill Review is a digital course designed for students to review and continue grade level standards to extend the school year for English Language Arts and Math. In this program, students will review English Language Arts standards through close reading and answering questions. For math, students will do problems with the teacher and practice grade appropriate math facts and problem-solving skills. This is intended to give students a safe space to practice academic skills without being graded.

### Kindergarten Gift Basket – A Kindergarten Toolkit

Grade TK-K

Give your incoming kindergartner the gift of a smooth transition! Students will be introduced to academic Kindergarten skill areas such as Reading, Writing, and Mathematics. With a focus on Kindergarten Common Core Standards, specific content areas will include: Alphabet and Number Recognition, Sight Word recognition, Sorting and Classifying Objects, Counting, Listening to and Sharing Ideas and Stories, and Socialization with their Peer Groups. Activities will include small and whole group instruction via Zoom (in place of small and whole group instruction in the physical classroom), followed by practice activities on Seesaw. Students will learn strategies and skills that they can continue to practice throughout the summer and as they transition to the new school year.

Small group instruction (2-3 students) in 15-minute increments allows for more personalized, differentiated, and efficient learning opportunities. Students are able to remain engaged throughout the 15 minutes and then access Seesaw to practice what they learned. With Seesaw (which is used during the regular Kindergarten school year), students use creative tools to take pictures, draw, record videos and more to capture learning in a digital portfolio. Teachers find or create activities to share with students. As a result of Seesaw being used for this summer program, your incoming kindergartner will enter kindergarten with the knowledge, foundational skills, and the confidence to be successful.

## Enrichment Courses

### First Grade Gift Basket – A First Grade Toolkit

Grade 1

This class provides a great way to keep a little routine, socialization and academic practice for your child to ensure a smooth transition into First Grade! Students will be introduced to academic First Grade skill areas such as Reading, Writing and Mathematics. Specific content areas will include: Reading and Writing Skills, Math and Number Concepts, Drama and Storytelling, Listening to and Sharing Ideas and Stories, Socialization with their peer group. Students will work in large and small groups via Zoom, as well as be provided with activities for guided and independent practice. Students will learn strategies and skills that they can continue to practice throughout the summer and as they transition to the new school year.

Small group instruction (2-3 students) in 15-minute increments allows for more personalized, differentiated, and efficient learning opportunities. Students are able to remain engaged throughout the 15 minutes and then access Seesaw to practice what they learned. With Seesaw (which is used during the regular Kindergarten school year), students use creative tools to take pictures, draw, record videos and more to capture learning in a digital portfolio. Teachers find or create activities to share with students. As a result of Seesaw being used for this summer program, your incoming first grader will have continued resources available for guided practice throughout the summer. Seesaw also keeps a digital portfolio and evidence of their learning so your child will continue to be ready for the next school year!

Students will be introduced to academic Second Grade content areas such as Reading, Writing, and Mathematics. Specific Language Arts content areas will include lessons that teach and reinforce lessons covering phonics, fluency, grammar, spelling, vocabulary, reading comprehension, and writing processes. Specific Math content areas will include lessons that teach and reinforce understanding of place value, standard units of measurement, build fact fluency in addition and subtraction, and identify and analyze geometric shapes.

English Language Arts will meet in morning sessions. Mathematics will meet in the afternoon sessions. The classes will include virtual mini lessons with the teacher each day along with practice and enrichment activities. Students will learn strategies and skills that they can continue to practice throughout the summer and as they transition to the new school year. As a result, your incoming second grader will enter with the knowledge, foundational skills, and the confidence to be successful.

Grades 2 – 5

What does every elementary school student need to know how to do before Upper Elementary or Middle School? They need to know how to write clearly, concisely and with a purpose. Grab your laptop or iPad. On your marks, get set, WRITE! This course is completely dedicated to the art of writing. Students will be exposed to several different genres of writing, including informative, opinion, and personal narrative. Students will learn how to write well written paragraphs, provide supporting details, and create pictures in the mind of their readers utilizing the five senses. Clear your mind and ignite your imagination as you jump into the pages of the written word. **NOTE – This class is not a preparatory class for the next grade level.**

In this course, students will utilize their math skills to problem solve brain teasers, play math games and complete math puzzles. Students will play board games, card games and use manipulatives and technology to help solve mathematical problems. **NOTE – This course is not a preparatory course for the next grade level. This course is PURE FUN!**
